◆What is Tabunka Free School?

Children who have already graduated from junior high school in their home countries, or who are over the age of 15 when they came to Japan are usually not allowed to enter public junior high school. Tabunka Free School was established to support children who need to study Japanese language and wish to go to a Japanese high school. We offer opportunities to study Japanese and other subjects(English and Math) as well as a place to belong to. We hope to provide thorough care so that students can realize their full potential in Japanese society.

Features

- We have certified Japanese language teachers who have experienced in teaching in public/private schools.
- Students can make friends under the multicultural atmosphere.
- We provide support including academic counseling, preparation for applying high school.

◆Curriculum

Japanese : Japanese lessons are designed for children of school ages. Classes are emphasized on developing reading & writing skills as well as ability of comprehension and thinking. Students will also practice writing essay and interview for high school entrance exam.

Other subjects : English and Math classes are also provided for preparation of high school entrance exam.

◆Others

- There will be meetings with parents regarding to high school and career path as needed.
- If a student has to miss classes for 1 week, please inform school in advance.

** Tuition includes support fees such as high school visit, prior qualification screening, interview practiceis, high school application, and admission documents.

** Summer term (August) is 4 hours/day.

** Original tuition is 70,000 yen per month with 20 hours class. However, thanks to donations from individual and corporate supporters, we are able to offer classes for 35,000 yen per month.

**Our school does not offer a leave of absence program.

3. Other cost

- Textbooks (3,000 yen/year) fee etc.

4. Payment and others

- Tuition and fees are due till the 10th of each month in cash. We will provide an envelop.
- Please note that once tuition and fees are received, we will not refund them.
- We may ask a student to leave the school when there is no payment for 2 month despite of reminder.
- Reduction of tuition may apply for students depending on family's financial situation.
If you wish to apply for this, please contact school staff.
- Student discount for transportation expenses cannot be used. We have support for the high transportation expenses if it costs over 10,000 yen/month.
- The winter semester runs through March.
